The funding source for this scholarship is based on the donations and sale of a scholarship animal at the Placer County Fair Junior Livestock Auction. Award Amounts and number of scholarships awarded each year will vary based on the number of applicants and the amount of funds generated in the previous year's auction. Scholarship recipients will be announced and awarded at the 2026 Placer County Fair Junior Livestock Auction.

Qualifications:

- ✓ Must be a graduating senior for the 2025-2026 academic year
- ✓ Must be a member of good standing in a 4-H, FFA, Grange and/or independent program at the time of graduation
- ✓ Must have had a minimum 2.5 GPA at the time of graduation
- ✓ Must be showing an animal at the Placer County Fair under a 4-H Club, Grange Club, FFA Chapter and/or Independent Exhibitor.
- ✓ Must provide a copy of the most recent high school transcript. Unofficial copies will be accepted with a counselor's signature. Official High School Transcripts will be required for selected applicants.
- ✓ Must show proof of acceptance/enrollment to a college, university, trade school, or military enlistment. Proof of enrollment will be required for selected applicants.
- ✓ Must provide a current resume
- ✓ Must provide 2 letters of recommendation (one must be from someone not involved in your 4-H and/or FFA program)
